Issue The "Add the Words, Idaho" Campaign is working toward amending the Idaho Human Rights Act to protect people of the LGBT community against discrimination in the workplace, housing, education, and in public school.

Project Description I worked with Dr. Caldwell-O'Keefe, Professor of LGBT studies at Boise State University, as well as Nicole LeFavour, ex-Senator of Idaho, who worked very hard for the "Add the Words, Idaho." My key message is this: Nobody in the state of Idaho should be treated without respect based on their sexual orientation and/or gender identity.
